This document provides basic information to assist with your stay. We suggest you print this out for reference.

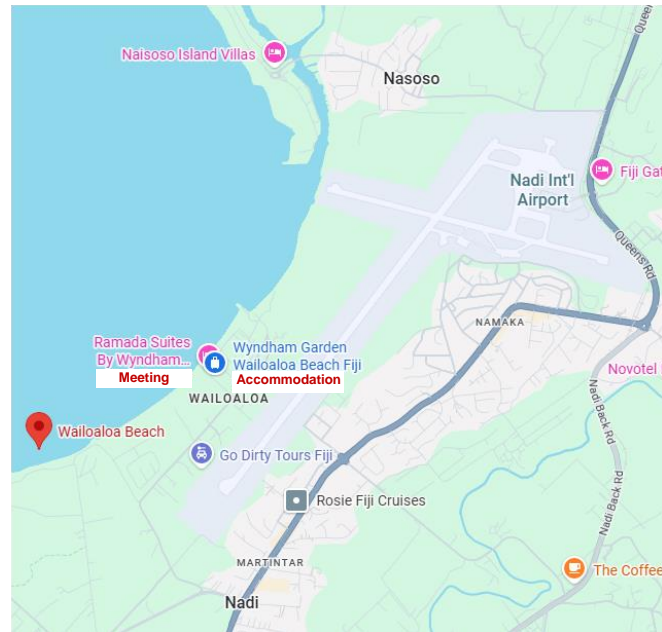

Accommodation:

- **Hotel:** Wyndham Garden Wailoaloa
- **Address:** Lot 18, Wasawasa Rd, Wailoaloa Beach, Nadi, Fiji
- **Phone:** (+679) 672 8888
- **Check-in/out:** Check In from 3pm and Check Out by 11am
- **Facilities:** Free breakfast buffet, free high-speed internet. Restaurant and bar on site.

Arrival and Transport:

- **Airport:** Nadi International Airport (NAN) is 8 km (5 miles) or 10 mins drive from the hotels.
- **Transfers:** Organised and paid in advance (with cost removed from travel grant/per diem).
- **Local Transport:** Taxis, car rentals, and buses are available. Taxis are a good option for short trips; ensure the meter is on and you have cash on hand.

Entry Requirements:

- **Passport validity:** Minimum of 6 months validity is necessary for travel.
- **Visa:** Check this [link](#) to see if you need a visa and organise this yourself (see [form](#)). Travellers from visa exempt countries will still need to get a permit on arrival.
- **Permit:** For visa-exempt travellers, a permit can be issued upon arrival. Declare your intent and purpose of travel and *show a valid passport, return flight ticket, hotel booking and PacMOSSI/PVN invite letter*. For more info, see [link](#).
- **Customs:** Refer to this [link](#) for a list of restricted and prohibited items.

Meeting Meals:

- Breakfast, morning tea, lunch, and afternoon tea are provided. Associated meal costs will be deducted from travel grant/per diem. Dinners will be paid by the participant.

Health & safety (see [SmartTraveller](#)):

- **Food, water, and disease prevention:** Drink boiled or sealed bottled water and avoid ice and raw or undercooked foods. Protect against mosquito bites (dengue, chikungunya, Zika) and avoid floodwaters (leptospirosis, typhoid). Keep vaccinations up to date.

- **Sexual health and blood safety:** An HIV outbreak has been declared - use protection and avoid contact with blood or unsterile equipment.
- **Healthcare limitations:** Medical services are limited and upfront payment is common. Serious cases may require evacuation.
- **Safety, security, and environment:** There is a risk of crime (especially at night and in urban areas), drink spiking, and card fraud. Flooding can disrupt access so follow local authorities guidance. Avoid protests and areas with military activity.

Currency & Payments:

- **Currency:** Fijian Dollar (FJD, \$) with \$1 AUD = \$1.56 FJD and \$1 USD = \$2.26 FJD (7 April 2026). *Please ensure you bring cash for exchange if needed.*
- **ATMS:** Available but with a surcharge of around 3-5% - be weary of ATM skimming.
- **Credit Cards:** Accepted in most hotels, restaurants and tourist areas, cash is essential for local markets, small purchases and in rural areas.

Climate & Clothing:

- **Temperature:** Max average temp: 27 degrees and Minimum average temp: 20 degrees (usually in evenings).
- **Rainfall:** June is drier, an average of 113mm.
- **Clothing:** Smart casual for meeting, modest dress recommended in public and rural areas.

Communication:

- **Internet:** Free high-speed internet provided at the hotel.
- **Mobile:** Local sim cards available from Digicel and Vodafone.
- **Electricity:** Operates on a 240V, plug Type 1 (same as Australia). *Please ensure you bring an adaptor if needed.*

- **Garden of the Sleeping Giant** – A lush botanical garden in Fiji's Sabeto Valley featuring over 2,000 varieties of orchids and tropical plants.
- **Sri Siva Subramaniya Temple** – A vibrant Hindu Temple in Nadi, Fiji, known for colourful Dravidian architecture and cultural significance.
- **Sabeto Valley** – A scenic valley near Nadi lush with landscapes, thermal hot springs, mud pools, and natural attractions.
